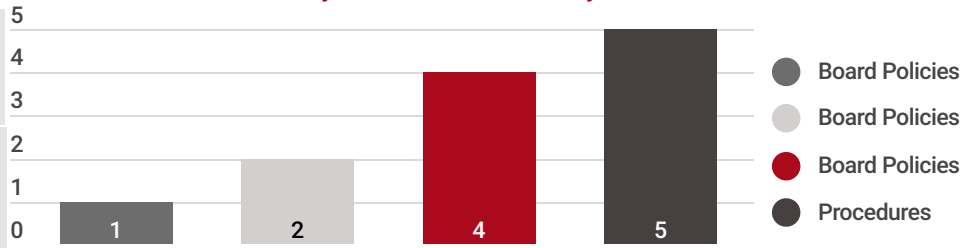
The institution establishes and follows policies and processes to ensure fair and ethical behavior on the part of its governing board, administration, faculty, and staff.

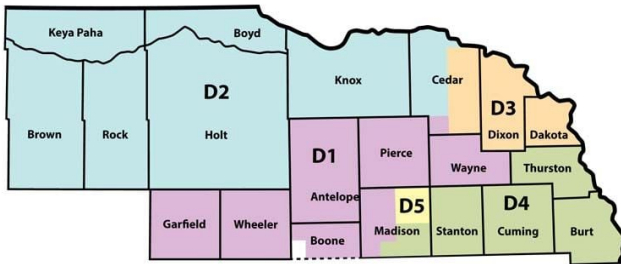
Policy/Procedure Review Cycles



Board Policies follow a multi-year cycle (1-4 years) of review per the Board Planning Cycle

The institution operates with INTEGRITY

- Board members annually sign Conflict of Interest statements
- Student Complaint Process
- Annual audit of the College's financial statements
- Hiring Process Procedures and Recruitment Protocols
- Harassment and Non-discrimination Procedures



Northeast is governed by an 11-member Board. Two members represent each voting district and one member serves at large.
