Measures course data, program data, and student outcomes trends for each program.

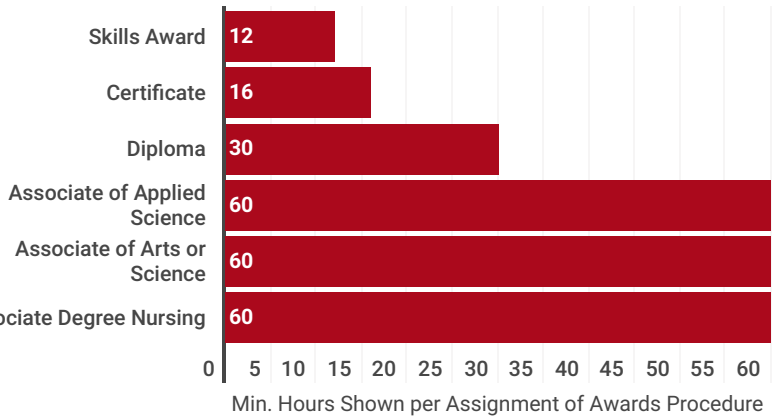


Comprehensive Program Review (years 4 & 7)
