Academic Program Review

 **Annual Program Review / Data Analysis**
Measures student outcome trends, course data, and program data. Supports course/program action plans for the following academic year.

 **Comprehensive Program Review (4-year and 7-year)**
Reviews student learning outcomes, syllabi, course descriptions, mission alignment, etc. for each program (7-year review also presents evidence for demand and efficiency). Supports comprehensive changes to programs for the next academic year and also used to report to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education.
