#### 6. BOARD EDUCATION AND INFORMATION

6.1 Financial Planning

Discussion was held regarding the process that Northeast Community College will follow in reference to levy discussions. Certified valuations will be received in August after which the board will hold discussions about the establishment of the levy. The new process for funding community colleges through the Community College Future Fund will begin a year from now and the board will have a discussion regarding the capital levy and general levy for next year's budget. Decisions will not be made until the information regarding the certified valuations is received.

### 7. PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing was held on the acquisition of real estate: A tract of land beginning at a point 590 feet West and 33 feet North of the Southeast Corner of Section 14, Township 24 North, Range 1 West of the 6th P.M., Madison County, Nebraska, thence North 180 feet; thence West 100 feet; thence South 180 feet; thence East 100 feet to the Point of Beginning, less that part deeded to the State of Nebraska described as referring to the Southeast Comer of the Southeast Quarter of Section 14, thence Northerly a distance of 33.01 feet along the East line of said Quarter Section; thence Westerly direction 091°11'21" left, a distance of 590.31 feet to the Southeast Corner of the property owned by the Grantor(s) to the Point of Beginning; thence Westerly deflecting 000°00'00" a distance of 100.00 feet to the Southwest corner of the property owned by the Grantor(s); thence Northerly deflecting 090°07'30" right, a distance of 2.00 feet along the West line of the property owned by the Grantor(s); thence Easterly deflecting 089°52'30" right, a distance of 100.0 feet to a point on the East line of the property owned by the Grantor(s); thence Southerly deflecting 090°07'30" right, a distance of 2.00 feet along said line to the point of beginning.
