- 1. The meeting was convened at 10:06 a.m. by Jeff Scherer, Chairperson of the Facilities Committee, via Zoom videoconferencing.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the July 16, 2020 meeting as distributed.
- 3. President Barrett provided the following construction progress report:
 - Hawks Village Punch list items are nearly complete and the close out and warranty documents are being processed.
 - Student Center Renovation and Addition In the renovation portion of the building the painting, acoustical ceiling and porcelain tile work nears completion. addition, the aluminum window frames are being installed and should be completed by the third week in August. Site work continues with the installation of sidewalks, light pole conduits, communications groundwork pipe and vaults, and irrigation sleeves. Sod is expected to be laid next week, weather permitting. We are continuing to work with Kingery Construction on the light fixture delivery delay. Our intent is to have most areas of the building substantially done by December 1st so that furniture can begin to be installed. Occupancy of the building is projected to be the first part of January.
 - Ag and Water Site grading at the Farms Operations/Large Animal area is nearing completion. Foundation work in this area has begun. The foundation on the Vet Tech building is complete and masonry wall installation has begun. Site utility installation is underway. The entire project is expected to be completed by July 2021.
