MINUTES

- 1. The meeting was convened at 2:10 p.m., in Room 1108B of the College Welcome Center, by Don Oelsligle, Chairperson of the Finance Committee.
- 2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the July 14, 2016 meeting.
- 3. Lynne Koski, Vice President of Administrative Services, reviewed paid bills for July 2016, focusing on bills in excess of \$5,000.
- 4. Lynne Koski provided a review of the Statements of Reimbursable Full-Time Equivalent Student Enrollment and Reimbursable Education Units for the years ended June 30, 2016 and 2015. Northeast received an unqualified opinion, or without material findings.

Lynne Koski provided clarification regarding the inclusion of Little Priest Tribal College and the Nebraska Indian Community College in the Enrollment Audit.
