

Board of Governors Questions and Answers

How often does the Board of Governors meet?

On a regular basis; usually monthly, the second Thursday of the month.

How long do board meetings last?

The length of the meeting depends on the number of agenda items and topics of discussion. Board members plan to commit most of the business day to attend.

Where are board meetings held?

Board meetings are held on the campus of Northeast Community College in Norfolk. However, the board attempts to conduct one meeting per year at its extended campuses.

Are there related duties to serving on the Board?

There are multiple opportunities to participate in special events during the College year such as commencement, intercollegiate athletic games, Achievement Awards event, to name a few. Opportunities exist for members to attend board-related activities sponsored by the Nebraska Community College Association (NCCA) and the Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT), e.g. ACCT conferences and seminars, NCCA meetings and annual conferences, etc.

Do board members receive compensation?

Board members do not receive compensation. Members receive reimbursement for travel, lodging, and related expenses (except alcohol) to and from Board-related activities.
