MINUTES

1. The Student Success Committee was convened at 2:25 p.m., in Suites F & G of the Lifelong Learning Center, by Donovan Ellis, Chairperson of the Student Success Committee.
2. Recommended approval of the Minutes of the August 11, 2021 meeting as distributed.
3. Review of the Fall 2021 Tenth Day Enrollment Report reveals the highest tenth day enrollment number in the last five years, with 5,072 students being registered. Compared to Fall 2019, Northeast third highest enrollment on record, enrollment is up 11% in headcount and 8% in credit hours.
4. Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) III student grant distribution plans include:
 - Students enrolled in 12 or more credit hours will receive \$2,500.00;
 - Students enrolled in six to 11 credit hours will receive \$1,250.00;
 - Students enrolled in less than six credit hours will not receive funding at this time.
