

REGIONAL IMPACT

Northeast not only contributes to the workforce through our skilled graduates and training programs, our regional economic impact is substantial to the northeast region of Nebraska. In a study conducted by Economic Modeling Specialists Intl. in 2022, it was found that Northeast contributed \$226.8 million to the regional economy through our graduates each year. This figure represents the higher earnings that students earned during the year, the increased output of the businesses that employed the students, and the multiplier effects that occurred as students and their employees spent money at other businesses. This added income is equivalent to supporting 3,200 jobs.
