JOB FUNCTIONS:

Turn or reposition bedridden patients

Answer patient call signals, signal lights, bells, or intercom systems to determine patients' needs

Feed patients or assist patients to eat or drink

Measure and record food and liquid intake or urinary and fecal output, reporting changes to medical or nursing staff

Provide physical support to assist patients to perform daily living activities, such as getting out of bed, bathing, dressing, using the toilet, standing, walking, or exercising

SKILLS:

Service Orientation, Active Listening, Social Perceptiveness, Monitoring, Coordination, Oral Comprehension, Speech Recognition, Problem Sensitivity

PROGRAM OUTCOMES:

Develop the skills needed to provide safe, effective, and caring services to the elderly, chronically ill or acute illness individuals in a long-term care facility, clinic, or hospital setting.
