Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Quarterly Report - September 30, 2021

Northeast Community College acknowledges that we have signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement assuring that we have and will use at least \$3,437,828 in emergency relief funds direct to students.

Northeast received a total amount of \$3,437,828 ARP Act funds to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to our students. As of September 30, 2021, the amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub.L. 117-2) is \$2,937,500. As of September 30, 2021, the total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Public Law 117-2 the American Rescue Plan Act is 1163.

Northeast defined exceptional need as students that have an expected family contribution (EFC) of 15000 or less. Students attending at full time status with an EFC of 15000 or less were awarded an emergency grant in the amount of \$2500. Students enrolled at least at half time status with an EFC of 15000 or less received an emergency grant in the amount of \$1250.00. As of September 30 the total number of students attending Northeast that met the definition of exceptional need as defined as an EFC of \$15,000 or less is 1,163 students. Additional distribution plans are currently being reviewed.
