Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Quarterly Report - June 30, 2021

Northeast Community College acknowledges that we have signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement assuring that we have and will use at least the same dollar amount of funds received under the CARES Act for emergency grants direct to students under the CRRSAA Act.

Northeast received a total amount of \$864,604.00 CRRSAA Act funds to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to our students. As of March 30, 2021, the amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the 18004 (a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA) is \$868,698.00. As of March 30, 2021, the total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA) is 944.

Northeast defined exceptional need as students that have an expected family contribution that is Pell grant eligible as determined by the FAFSA. Students attending at least at half time status were awarded an emergency grant in the amount of \$1000. Pell eligible students enrolled at less than half time received an emergency grant in the amount of \$250.00. As of March 30, 2021 the student portion of the CRRSAA funds have been expended.

Northeast utilized some of the institutional portion of the CRRSAA grant funds to provide tuition assistance to students enrolled in summer courses. As of June 30, 2021 an additional 29 students received CRRSAA grant funds from the institutional share in the amount of \$18,135 bringing the total amount of CRRSAA Emergency Grant funds disbursed directly to student to \$886,833.00.
