

## **Cost of Attendance Adjustments Form**

The Financial Aid Office uses a standard Cost of Attendance (COA) for all students based on an estimated average cost of tuition and fees, books and supplies, room and board, transportation, personal expenses, and loan fees. The COA sets the limit on the maximum amount of financial aid a student may receive for the academic year.
For special circumstances, the Financial Aid Office may use their professional judgment on a case-by-case basis to adjust a student's COA. A COA adjustment may increase a student's Federal Direct Loan eligibility, if the maximum annual eligibility has not been used, or it may increase a student's Federal Direct PLUS or private loan eligibility. Information you provide on this form allows the Financial Aid office to review and consider additional educational expenses incurred during your period of enrollment.
Please note the following:

- You are not required to complete the Cost of Attendance adjustment form if your expenses do not exceed your cost of attendance.
