Spring registration opens early December.

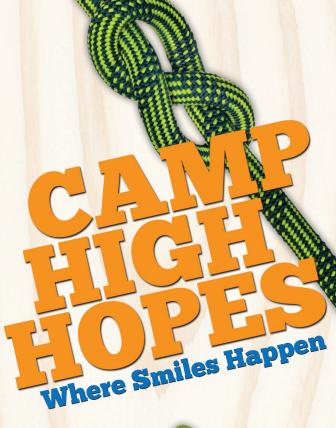

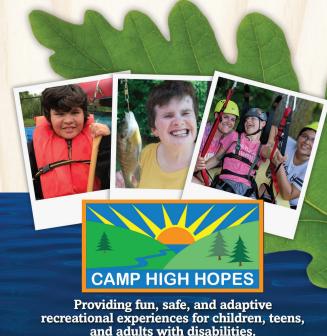




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SPRING AND FALL (SEPT-MAY)
