Educational Service Unit 8 provides services to children from birth to 21 years of age in a 7 county area. 18 public schools contract with ESU 8 to provide one or more of the following services:

- Early Childhood Special Education
- Speech Language Therapy
- Deaf Education
- Psychology
- Vision Instruction
- Mental Health Services with an LMHP
- Level III Life Skills. Programs in Norfolk and Clearwater for students ages 5-21
- Level III Behavior Program in Clearwater for students in grades K-6

Children from birth to 3 years old receive services in their homes or at daycare centers. Preschool aged children receive services at public or private preschools, daycare centers, or homes.

Educational Service Unit 8 also helps high school students get connected with Vocational Rehabilitation or Developmentally Disabilities to help them transition to education, employment, and independent living after they graduate.

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
