— 1913

In Axtell, Nebraska, the **Bethphage Inner Mission Association** is founded by the Rev. K.G. William Dahl and more than 50 charter members who each gave \$1 to create a home for people who were on the fringe of society.



— 1925

In the library of the vacant Martin Luther Academy in Sterling, Nebraska, **Martin Luther Home** is founded as a school for children with developmental disabilities.



— 2003

Bethphage and Martin Luther Home become **Mosaic**, the largest faith-based provider of services to people with disabilities in the U.S.

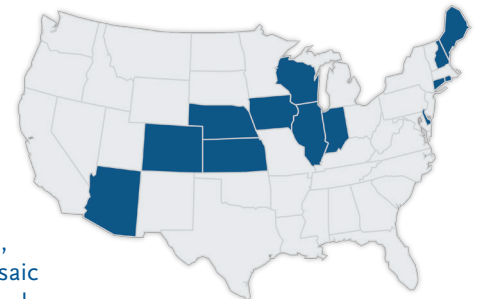
Mosaic continues to embrace transformation—integrating people served more fully into the community where they are welcomed, listened to and able to build reciprocal relationships.

Giving a Voice

Services

Group Setting

Three or more people live in a shared setting where support staff are present 24/7 to help people acquire, retain or improve skills related to the activities of daily living.

Mosaic at Home

A contractor provides a shared living environment and 24/7 support to help people acquire, retain or improve skills required for the activities of daily living and to be part of the community.

Supported Living (Hourly)

People receive goal-oriented, skill-building support (intermittently, hourly, etc.) for independence in their own home or family home. Includes respite care.

Day Services

People receive a range of supports and/or a variety of therapeutic services to foster life skills for independence and promote physical and social health. Activities are provided in various settings.

Other Services Include:

- **Employment Skills**
- **Mental and Behavioral Health and Autism**



Since 1992, Mosaic in Northeast Nebraska has supported people with diverse needs and currently serves more than **90 people**.
