ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

1. POLICY REASON/PURPOSE/INTENT

To establish a policy on alcoholic beverages and controlled substances.

2. DEFINITIONS

3. POLICY

3.1 The unauthorized and/or unlawful manufacture, distribution, possession, or use of alcohol or a controlled substance as defined by the federal Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S. C§801 et. seq) or Nebraska Uniform Controlled Substances Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §28-401 to §28-456.01 and §28-458 to §28-462), as such laws may from time to time be amended, is strictly prohibited in all College facilities, on all property of the College including College vehicles, and at College sponsored activities held off-campus. This prohibition applies to any person on College grounds, whether he or she is a member of the College community or not.

3.2 Students and student employees are prohibited from reporting to any curricular or co-curricular class/activity, work, and/or from operating or using any College equipment, machinery, or vehicle while under the influence of alcohol as defined by Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-6,196 or impaired by the use or ingestion of a controlled substance.

3.3 Students who violate this policy are subject to disciplinary action.
