Governance Process Policy Policy Number: GP - 17

Recognition

The Board shall determine the nature of the contributions to the College that merit recognition and in a manner that reflects Owners values and pertinent statutes.

1. Consistent with Local Government Miscellaneous Expenditure Act, the Board will establish a dollar limit for the expenditure of public funds for plaques, certificates of achievement, or items of value awarded to elected or appointed officials, employees, or volunteers, including persons serving on local government boards or commissions. The Board will not change the limit more than once in a twelve-month period. (§13-2203)
 - 1.1. As of January 1, 2022, the expenditure of public funds for non-alcoholic beverages and meals provided at one recognition dinner each year held for elected and appointed officials, employees, or volunteers shall not exceed fifty dollars per person.
 - 1.1.1. An annual recognition dinner may be held separately for employees of each department or separately for volunteers, or any of them in combination.
 - 1.2. As of January 1, 2022, the expenditure of public funds for plaques, certificates of achievement, or items of value awarded to elected or appointed officials, employees, or volunteers, including persons serving on local government boards or commissions shall not exceed seventy-five dollars.

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
