When order is placed, date of delivery is given. (Most are on Saturdays). Buy as many boxes as you want.

Prices are about \$25.00 per box and up, varying by state.

volunteers. If you are interested in Bountiful Baskets continuing, please volunteer occasionally. The contribution is \$18 – \$22 per basket depending on the geographic location and cost of produce in that region and the amount of tax the group is charged when purchasing from resellers. Must sign up online and prepay for produce on Monday/Tuesday and pick up on weekend. Ran by volunteers.
